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General Guidelines:

- (i) The students already honored with this award are not eligible to apply again.
- (ii) Interested students shall apply through the Head of Division/Centre/Section in the prescribed application form available at the Director’s Cell, Heads of Divisions/SICs of Centre’s/ Director of the Institute/Dean, Fisheries College. The application shall be neatly typed, duly certified, signed and forwarded through proper channel. The application form available on the CIFE website (www.cife.edu.in).
- (iii) The relevant period of reporting and consideration for the award would be for degree awarded between 01.04.2016 to 31.3.2017 for the award of 2017.
- (iv) The filled in Application Form should be sent as a mail attachment to the **Director, ICAR-Central Institute of Fisheries Education, (Deemed University), Panch Marg, Off Yari Road, Versova, Andheri (West), Mumbai – 400 061** **in soft Copy only on or before 06.08.2020 in his mail ID (gopalkrishna@cife.edu.in).**

- (v) Looking into Covid-19 situation in Mumbai, the award shall be given in a memorial lecture day-cum-function, to be organized on a suitable date, on Dr. C.V. Kulkarni at ICAR - Central Institute of Fisheries Education, (Deemed University), Panch Marg, Off Yari Road, Versova, Andheri (West), Mumbai – 400 061.
- (vi) Central Institute of Fisheries Education, Mumbai will contribute towards the travelling expenses of student selected for the award at a rate corresponding to the amount of 2nd Class/ Sleeper Mail railway fare by the shortest route to the place from the Railway Station nearest to the normal place of residence of the student or from where he/she actually performs the journey, whichever, is nearer to the CIFE, Mumbai, and back to the same station or the amount of Railway fare actually incurred by the student whichever is less provided he/she fulfill all the conditions. No student from Mumbai local will be paid travel allowance in any case.
